# Band Camp Information 2009

Dear 2009 LHS Lancer Band Members and Parents:

This Packet is intended to give you complete details of the 2009 Lakewood High School Band Camp. The camp will be held Sunday, August 16<sup>th</sup> through Friday, August 21<sup>st</sup> at the Ohio Retreat Center near Marengo, Ohio. All students will be transported to and from camp by school busses. Students should be at LHS no later than 1:00PM on Sunday the 16th, and may be picked up at LHS at approximately 3:45PM on Friday the 21<sup>st</sup>.

The fee for camp is \$160.00. If you have more than one child attending camp, the fee for each additional child is \$140.00. Make checks payable to Lakewood Band Boosters, Inc. Money may be paid anytime from now until we leave for camp on the 16<sup>th</sup>. The Band Booster Treasurer will be on hand each evening of Pre-Camp to take payments and make payment arrangements.

All students are covered by accident insurance (excess coverage) from Nationwide Insurance during their stay at camp. The cost of this insurance is included in the camp fee. I must have a new EMF (Emergency Medical Form) from each student. When completing these forms, please include your doctor's and dentist's phone numbers. Also list the date of your child's last tetanus shot, if known.

Also, any student taking **ANY** type of medication during the week must have an Authorization to Administer Medication form filled out and signed by a doctor. Please fill out and return the medicine authorization form if you are taking ANY medicine including Tylenol or Advil (or equivalents). Students who are taking prescription OR non-prescription medication must give it to our nurse when they arrive on Sunday. She will then issue it to the student when needed.

## CHECK-IN PROCEDURES FOR CAMP

**All check-in will take place in on the Auditorium Stage.**

1. Check in at the registration table in the auditorium.
2. Turn in any outstanding forms (EMF, Handbook, etc)
3. Turn in any Authorization to Administer Medication forms AND turn over medication to the band camp nurse.
4. Pay any remaining camp, uniform, or uniform maintenance fees.
5. Put suitcases and instruments on the assigned truck.
6. Double check your packing list and make certain you have all music, instrument, mouthpiece, neck strap, mallets, sticks etc. that you will need for camp.
7. Get on your assigned bus, find a seat, and stay seated.

## PACKING LIST

The following is a list of items which should and should not be taken to camp by each student. **Parents...please check your child's suitcase before they leave!**

### **DO NOT BRING:**

- Shaving Cream or anything else that can make a mess
- Large tubes of toothpaste
- Firecrackers or fireworks of any kind
- Tobacco products, lighters, illegal drugs, alcohol, pocket knives or other weapons
- Excessive cash or expensive items

### **DO BRING:**

- Bedding: pillow, sheets and blanket and/or sleeping bag
- Toiletry Articles (toothbrush, small tube of toothpaste, soap, shampoo, towels, washcloths, deodorant, comb/ brush, and any other needed articles)
- Clothes
  - Comfortable marching clothes (shorts, jeans, t-shirts etc.)
  - Socks (several pairs), and underwear
  - Comfortable marching shoes (one or two pairs – Tennis Shoes - NO SANDALS!)
  - Jacket, sweatshirt or sweater
  - Swim suit and towel
  - Hat (for sun protection)
- Miscellaneous: Flashlight, insect repellent, sunscreen, water bottle, money for soda machines each day and Pizza on Thursday night, and reeds for woodwind players. **DO NOT BRING A LOT OF MONEY.** Pizza typically costs around \$5 per student, and soda to purchase requires coin change.
- Instrument, mouthpiece, music, pencil(s) reeds, sticks, mallets, etc.
- High expectations for yourself, and the entire LANCER BAND!
